

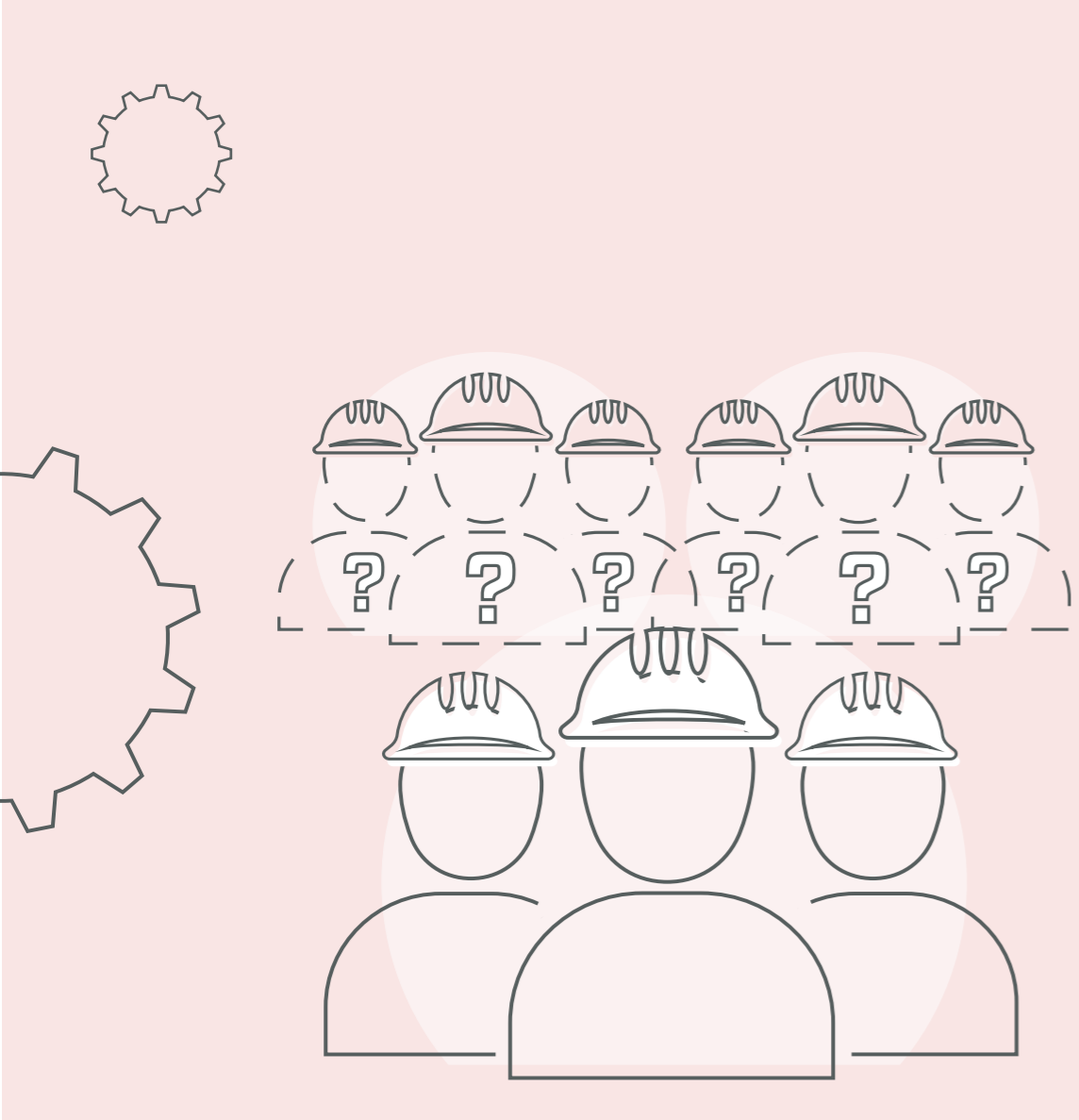
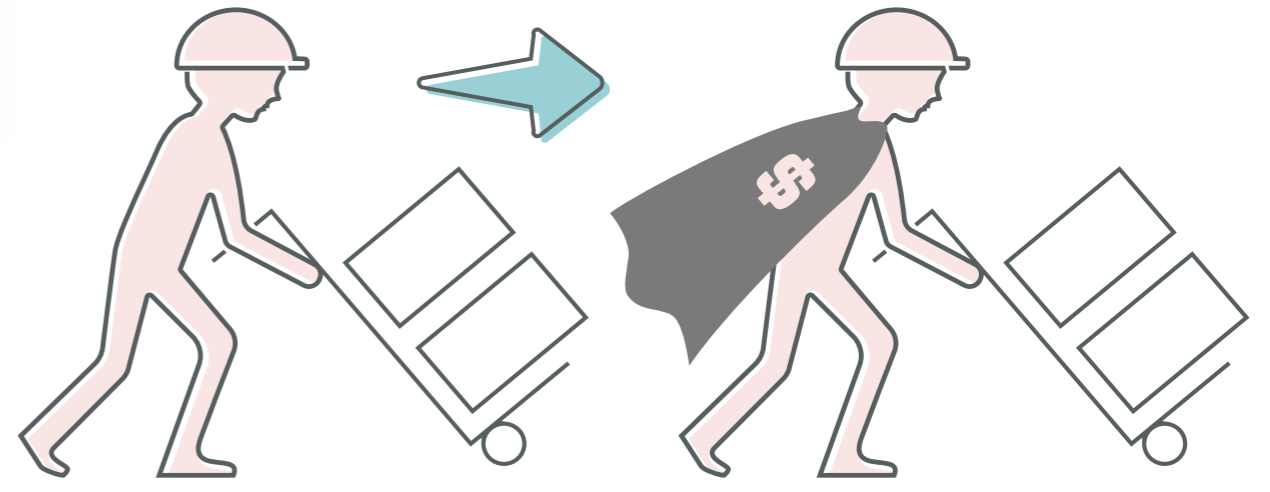
AUTOMATION: It's About More Than Fewer People

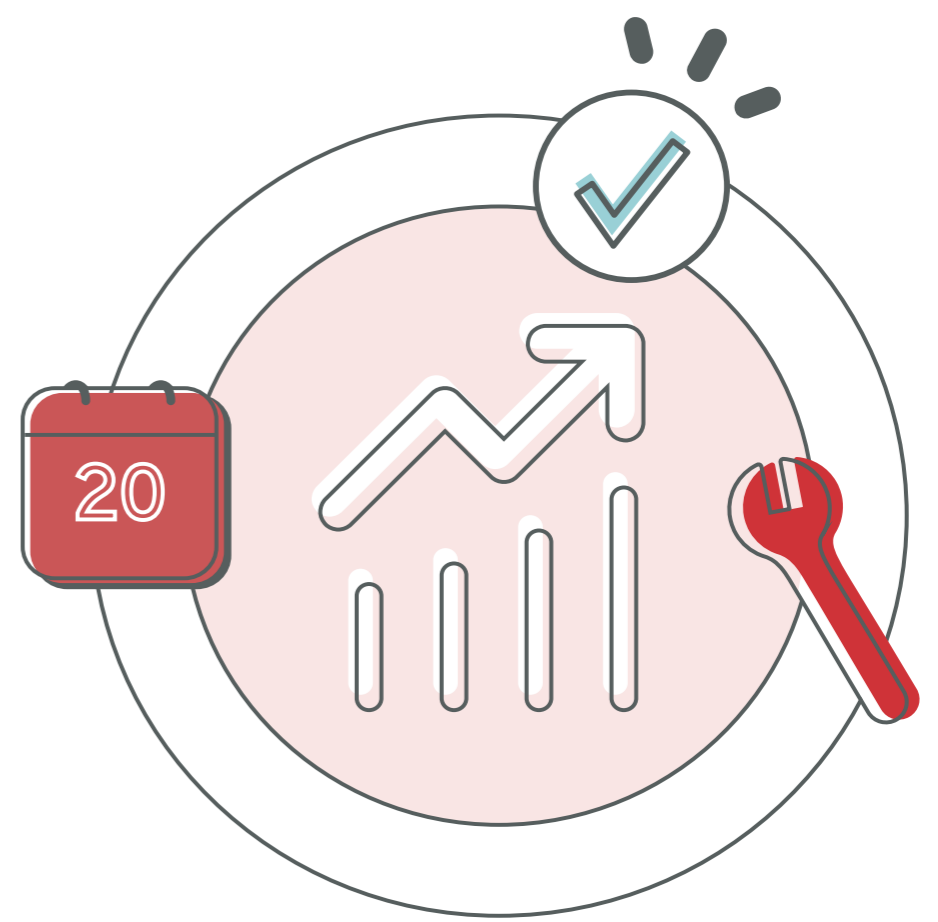


2 Reduce Staffing Uncertainty
